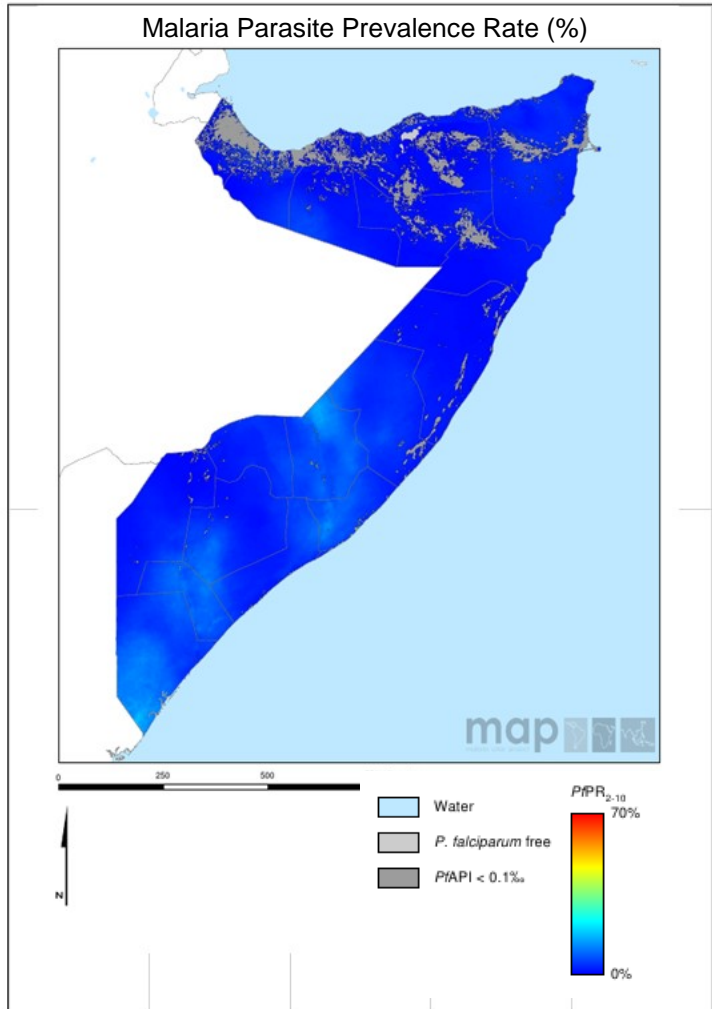


Scorecard for Accountability and Action



Malaria transmission ranges from unstable and epidemic in Puntland and Somaliland to moderate in central Somalia to high in the south. The annual reported number of malaria cases in 2014 was 26,174 and 14 deaths.

Progress

Somalia has secured adequate funding for the procurement and distribution of the majority of the ACTs and RDTs required in 2016. Somalia has scaled up iCCM.

Impact

The annual reported number of malaria cases in 2014 was 26,174 and 14 deaths. WHO, through modeling, estimates that there has been a less than 50% decrease in malaria incidence between 2000 and 2015.

Previous Key Recommended Actions

Somalia has responded positively to the MNCH recommended actions addressing low coverage and lack of data for a number of key interventions including skilled birth attendants, exclusive breastfeeding and vitamin A and continues to track progress as these actions are implemented.
